

## Arranging the Fellowship Hall for COVID Safety

Our current adult Sunday School class is so well attended that we have needed to consider how to arrange seating in light of the risks of Coronavirus sharing. One way to manage the space is shown here:



A new twist that will add more space is to use the virtual space of a Zoom session. This allows for people who cannot find a seat in the fellowship hall to participate from elsewhere in the building. It also provides a way to attend Sunday School from outside the church by people at home or away from the Tecumseh area.

At present, we can do the Zoom session using a laptop pointed into the room and connected to a larger desktop screen. We may, at some future time, want to install a permanent webcam and larger display screen to provide a more effective way to facilitate remote participation (. . . a funding project or donation target?).
