Current Challenges:

Too few volunteers . . .

Only two (one being me) is leading the VCI work – this is making it very difficult to keep things on track

Summer diversions and schedules –

- vacations, travel, weekends (or more) at cottages by a variety of lakes
- committees do not meet during the summer

Non-VCI projects –

- Fresh Food Initiative food giveaways one weekend a month takes most of our available volunteers
- VBS will be using most of our participating volunteers (7/29-8/4)
- Basic doctrine/bible/theology currently being developed and taught by the pastor every two weeks

Pastor has very little time to lead another two book studies and the other person working actively on VCI is also our treasurer, thus has little extra time as well

Options for mitigation:

Give up on VCI (worst option)

Recruit more volunteers to lead VCI projects (if this was easy, we'd have done it by now)

Sideline non-VCI projects

Extend our implementation schedule
