## FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Who were invited to be interviewed by the Consultation Team?**

**A:** As specified by the VCI Self-Study Guide “*key leaders such as, the Lay Leader, Ad Council Chair, children’s ministries, youth ministries, hospitality, finance, trustees, SPRC, UMW, UMM, etc.*” (p. 8) Thus, we invited committee chairpersons, except for Trustees, who was represented by its treasurer and who also represented our Endowment Fund Trustees, as well as the choir and handbell choir directors, and the administrative assistant. In addition a couple of our newest members were interviewed. A couple other people were added by request of the consultant to who led the Pre-Consultation Workshop because they had attended that event on Saturday, May 12.

**Q: I was led to believe that we would be asked to change our music. Is this buried in the report and I just haven’t seen it yet?**

**A:** No. Our music is very good and an asset. The only place that the report mentions it is in a passing reference to how good it is.

**Q: What if we have trouble meeting the dates specified in the prescriptions? For example, they specify an electronic outdoor sign perpendicular to Bishop Reed Drive installed by April 1, 2019, which may be difficult.**
